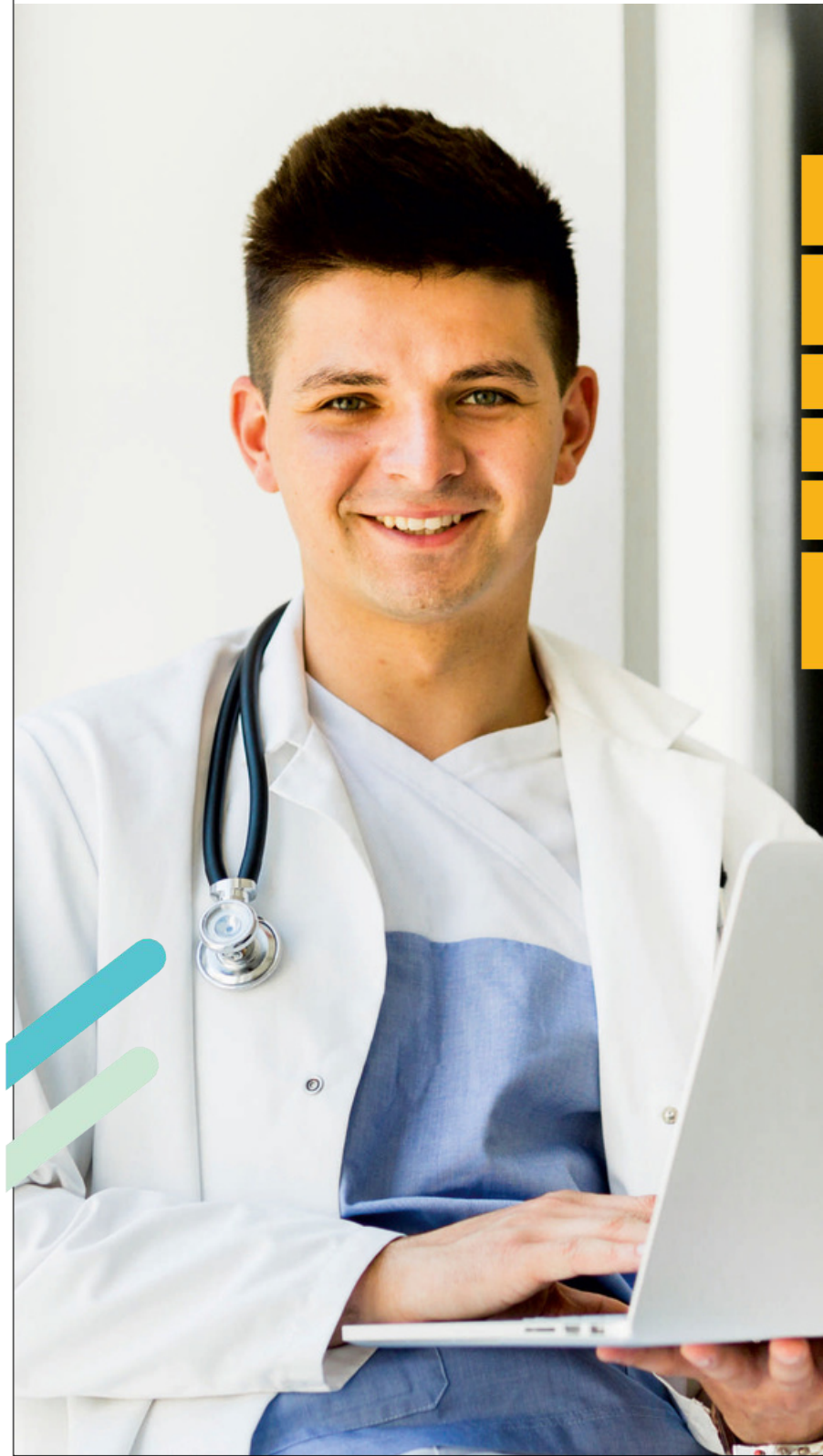

Global Licensing & Career Pathways

USMLE Pathway (United States)

DBU Americas MD degree follows a US-style medical curriculum, making it suitable for students targeting the **USMLE pathway**.

Pathway: - MD Degree from DBU Americas - USMLE Step 1 & Step 2 CK - Clinical rotations / electives (after eligibility) - Residency Match in the USA

Earning Potential (Indicative): - Residents: USD 55,000–65,000 per year -
Practicing Physicians: USD 200,000–350,000+ per year (varies by specialty)

PLAB Pathway (United Kingdom)

Graduates can pursue registration with the **GMC (UK)** through the PLAB route.

Pathway: - MD Degree - PLAB 1 & PLAB 2 - GMC Registration - NHS employment

Earning Potential: - FY Doctor: GBP 32,000–37,000 per year -
Specialist Doctors: GBP 70,000–120,000+ per year

MCCQE Pathway (Canada)

Students can also explore the **Canada medical licensing route**. **Pathway:** - MD Degree - MCCQE Part 1 - NAC OSCE - Residency (highly competitive)

Earning Potential: - Residents: CAD 60,000–70,000 per year -
Practicing Physicians: CAD 180,000–300,000+ per year

Returning to India – NMC Guidelines (2021)

Indian students wishing to practice in India must comply with **NMC Foreign Medical Graduate Regulations 2021**:

- ◆ NEET qualification is mandatory for admission.
Minimum course duration: 54 months + 12 months internship
- ◆ Medium of instruction must be English.
Clinical training must be completed as per regulations
- ◆ Mandatory screening exam (FMGE/NEtAs applicable)

DBU Americas aligns its academic structure to support compliance with these guidelines.
